

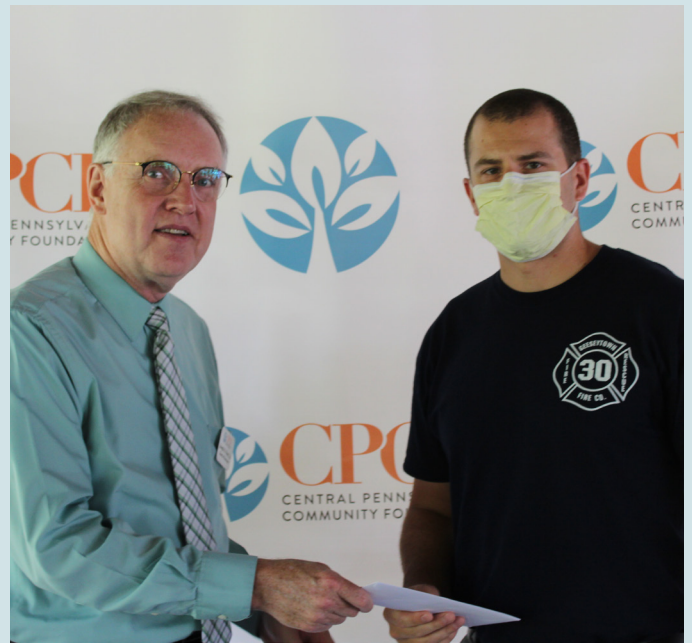

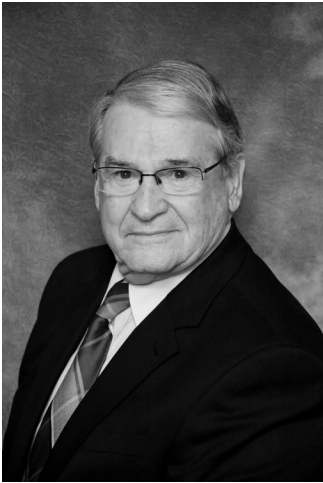

The CPCF was blessed with Fred's leadership, service, and generosity. He will be dearly missed by the Foundation.



25 YEARS - NOT THE YEAR WE EXPECTED

2020 started with the excitement of our organization reaching a major milestone – 25 years. Special plans to commemorate a quarter of a century were being finalized. And, as we all know, the best-laid plans...

Our organization officially began on March 24, 1995, when the Greater Altoona Blair County Community Endowment became a 501(c)3 charitable organization. From assets of \$39,000 in 1996 to over \$25 million under management and administration at the end of 2020, we manage 272 funds created by generous donors interested in improving our community. Since inception, CPCF has distributed grants and scholarships totaling over \$20 million to over 750 organizations and over 1,500 deserving students, including 155 scholarships totaling over \$148,000 in 2020.

2020 was to be a year of celebration, but unfortunately COVID-19 put a stop to our events. However, in the weeks immediately following the "shutdown of Pennsylvania," we were able to help our donors provide over \$109,000 specifically for COVID-19 related support.

To celebrate our 25th year, we decided one thing would not be canceled - the distribution of special grants totaling \$25,000. Five charitable organizations were selected to each receive a \$5,000 award. 25th Anniversary Grant Award Recipients included: Big Brothers Big Sisters of Blair County, The Blair County Historical Society, The Door Student Services, Gloria Gates Memorial Foundation, and John's Way Medical Equipment Ministry.

Although none of our planned celebrations were held, we are so proud of so many positive things that happened at your Community Foundation last year!

We sincerely thank those of you who have already been a part of the Community Foundation; none of our successes over the past 25 years would have been possible without you. Those who haven't yet, join us and let's see what we can accomplish together in the next 25 years and beyond!

ABOUT US

The Central Pennsylvania Community Foundation (CPCF) was created as a result of the dedication of several community minded residents, many of whom are still active with the organization today. Originally called the Greater Altoona Blair County Community Endowment, the Foundation became a 501(c)3 on March 24, 1995.

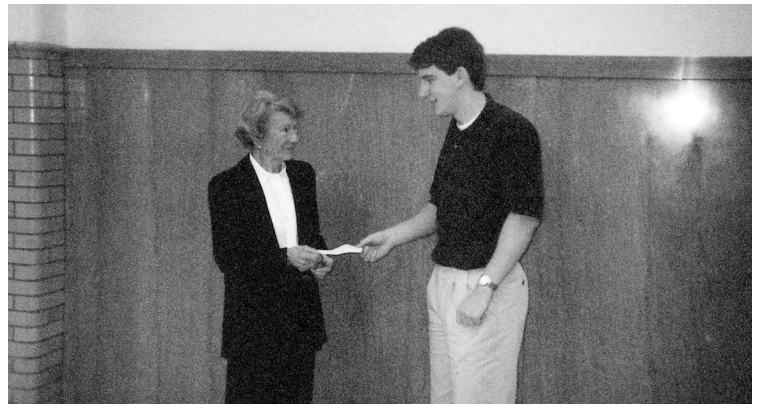
The year 2000 was a year of significant firsts for the CPCF. Perhaps the most impactful was the creation of the first corporate endowment by the McLanahan Corporation. By the end of 2000, the organization reached its first million dollars in assets under management.

The dedication and passion of many community minded residents helped the organization flourish in its early years.

A significant milestone in the CPCF's history, the Altoona Foundation became part of the Community Endowment in 2001. Judge Thomas Peoples signed the petition to transfer the funds from the Altoona Foundation, founded in 1924, into the Community Endowment, merging a shared passion for the growth of the region.

In 2003, the Foundation changed its name to the Central Pennsylvania Community Foundation and established its own office space at 1330 11th Avenue, Altoona, which is our current location.

Over the years, the Foundation has continued to grow and prosper with funds, scholarships, grants, and donors increasing every year. With great pride, the CPCF celebrated its 25th Anniversary on March 24, 2020.

FUNDS YOU CAN CREATE



UNDESIGNATED FUNDS

This is a fund for the greater good, meaning the funds may be used for any purpose. As the name implies, there are no restrictions on the way the money can be allocated, making it ideal for a fund with broad philanthropic interests. Undesignated funds will be managed by the Central Pennsylvania Community Foundation in order to properly distribute support to projects and organizations that can best make use of it.

DESIGNATED FUNDS

The opposite of an undesignated fund, this option allows ongoing support for specific charitable organizations. When establishing a designated fund, you'll be able to choose one or more organizations to automatically receive annual grants from your fund in perpetuity.

DONOR-ADVISED FUNDS

While this style of fund shares the broad nature of an unrestricted fund, it differs in one important way — it allows you to have an ongoing say in suggesting ways your gift should be used to benefit the community. This makes donor-advised funds a highly personal and flexible way to impact the community.

FIELD-OF-INTEREST FUNDS

Unlike a designated fund that selects one or several individual organizations to support, a field-of-interest fund provides the flexibility to support many organizations under a focused area of impact. The benefit of this style of fund is that it focuses on supporting a cause instead of a specific organization, ensuring that no matter who is making breakthroughs in the area you're passionate about, you will be able to support them.

SCHOLARSHIP FUNDS

While other types of funds invest in causes and organizations, a scholarship fund allows you to invest in people, providing the community's students with the support needed to achieve. These funds can be designated from preschool all the way up to postgraduate studies as you see fit, and are often established to memorialize a loved one.

AGENCY FUNDS

You align your charitable organization with the CPCF. Instead of having to establish their own foundation, charitable organizations can establish an agency fund under the CPCF umbrella. This ensures long-term funding and alleviates often complex administrative duties.

Administrative Fees Policy

The administrative fees charged by the Foundation for a fund are as follows:

- 1.5% of the first \$100,000 or \$150 whichever is greater
- 1.25% of the next \$100,001 - \$499,999
- 1% of any amount over \$500,000

Administrative fees will be collected on a quarterly basis.

NOTE: For a pass-through account, a maximum fee of 2.5% will be charged as determined by the Finance Committee based on duties and administrative responsibilities.

LEGACY SOCIETY

As of December 31, 2020

The Legacy Society members are those who have named the Central Pennsylvania Community Foundation as the beneficiary of any type of planned or deferred gift. Composed of individuals who have made plans to leave a gift to the Central Pennsylvania Community Foundation, members of the Legacy Society have that special satisfaction that comes with knowing that they have helped make this corner of the world a little better.

Legacy Society members may designate the use of the distributions from their future gifts, or may leave the distributions to the discretion of the Grants Committee. A Legacy Society gift may be used to establish a new Named Fund or may be added to any of the Foundation's existing funds. There are many not-for-profit organizations worthy of consideration and support, but the "ultimate philanthropy" is the Foundation itself. Gifts supporting the Foundation will ensure our ability to create a better future for all of us.

GIFTING OPTIONS

There are many options for charitable giving. With all options, you should always contact your tax advisor.

CASH

Since the CPCF is a public charity, your gift qualifies for the maximum tax benefits. Gifts of cash are deductible up to 60% of your adjusted gross income; any excess amount may be carried forward for deduction over the next 5 years.

STOCKS & BONDS

When gifting stocks, bonds, or mutual funds, you'll receive a deduction equal to the current market value of the securities and avoid the capital gains tax on any long-term appreciation. Gifts of stocks and bonds are deductible up to 30% of your adjusted gross income and any excess amount may be carried forward for deduction over the next 5 years.

LIFE INSURANCE

Your life insurance policy may be used for a charitable gift. You can name the Foundation as the beneficiary of an existing policy or donate a policy you no longer need. You may find that purchasing a new policy for the Foundation may afford you the opportunity to create a much larger fund. The premiums you pay for such a policy are deductible from your income tax.

RETIREMENT ACCOUNT ASSETS & IRAS

Careful planning is needed to ensure excess taxes are not incurred. Some IRAs have been taxed as much as 80% due to lack of adequate tax planning. However, they do provide a special opportunity to establish a fund.

CHARITABLE BEQUEST

A charitable bequest is a gift that is made part of a will or trust. There are many ways that a charitable bequest can be set up. The CPCF team can work with you and your attorney to include one into your estate plan.

CHARITABLE LEAD TRUST

If you are interested in supporting specific causes for a specific period of time, with remaining assets eventually going to your heirs or beneficiaries, a charitable lead trust may be a good fit for you.

CHARITABLE REMAINDER TRUST

A charitable remainder trust is a strategy that can generate a lifetime income for the donor(s). Upon death, the remainder is donated to the designated charity.

REAL ESTATE

This and other assets are accepted by the Foundation on a case-by-case basis.

SUSTAINING VISIONARY

Contributions to the Sustaining Visionary Fund provide additional funding for the Community Foundation's competitive grant program. You may direct your contribution to one of the following areas: Animals, Arts, Economic and Community Development, Educational Programs, Health Related, or Social Services.

Donations (you set the amount) to the Sustaining Visionary Fund may be billed on an annual or semi-annual basis.

If you are interested in becoming part of the Sustaining Visionary Fund, just contact the Community Foundation office.

EDUCATIONAL IMPROVEMENT TAX CREDIT (EITC)

In Pennsylvania, tax credits are available to eligible businesses contributing to a Scholarship Organization, an Educational Improvement Organization (EIO), Opportunity Scholarship Tax Credit (OSTC), and/or a Pre-Kindergarten Scholarship Organization. Previously the CPCF accepted contributions to any of the 4 programs. Currently, we are only accepting EIO contributions.

In 2020, the CPCF began to handle Special Purpose Entity: Educational Improvement Organizations (EIO) contributions. This new program is available from January 1 – August 31 each year. Individual business owners, who are new donors, and agree to make at least a \$3,500 contribution could be eligible for this program. 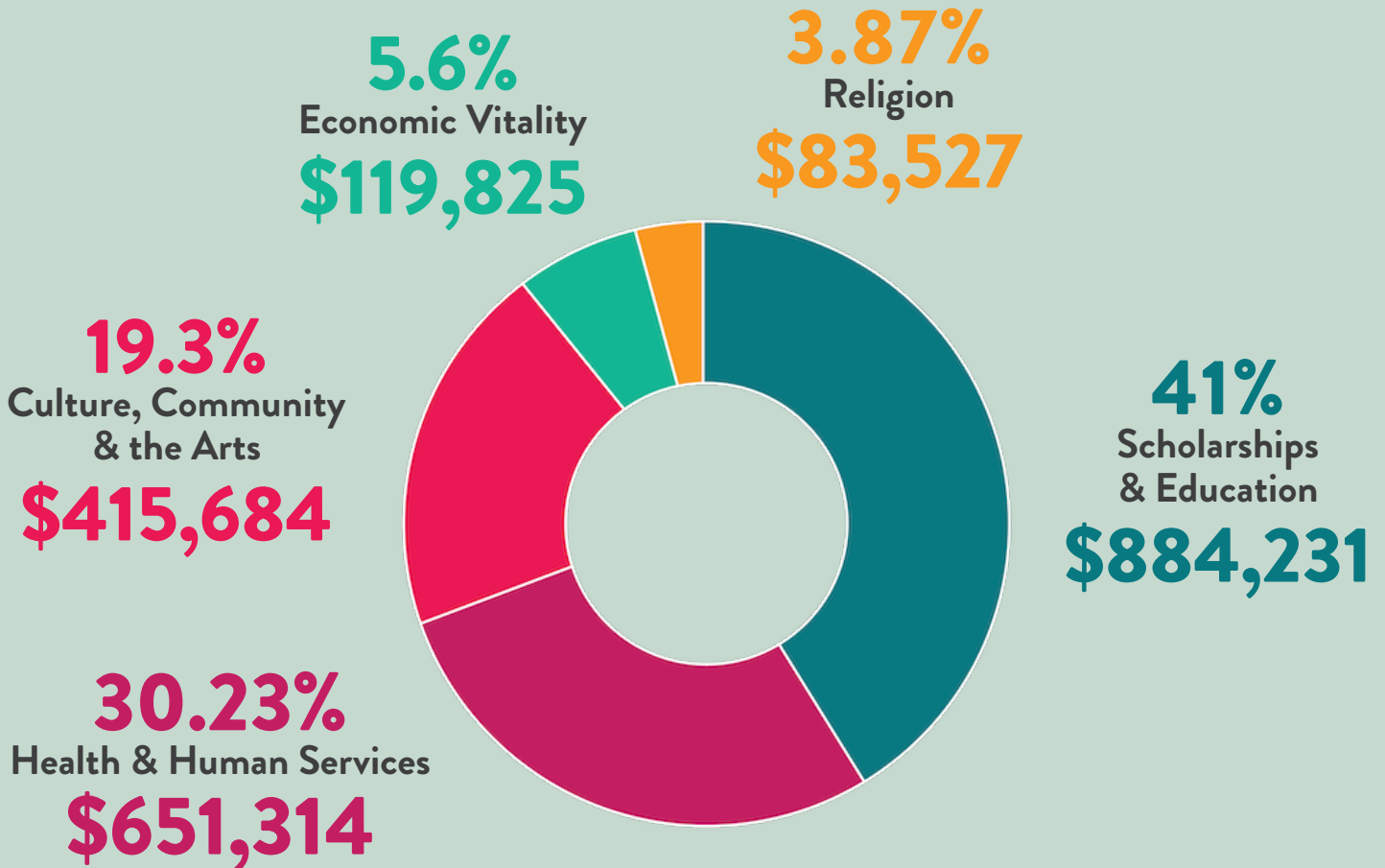

Michael McLanahan serves as the Chairman of the Board at McLanahan Corporation. He is extremely

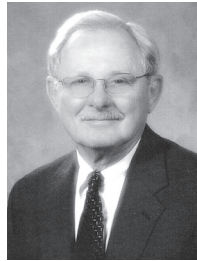

Robert and Evelyn 'Evie' Hite were a shining example

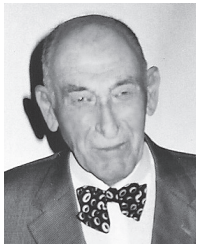

2002 - Donald E. Wissinger



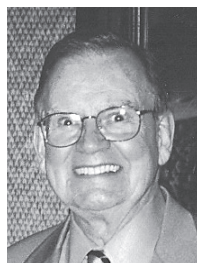
After working in academia until 1960, Don and wife, Flossie, became instrumental in growing the Wissinger family grocery business from one to five supermarkets in Blair County.

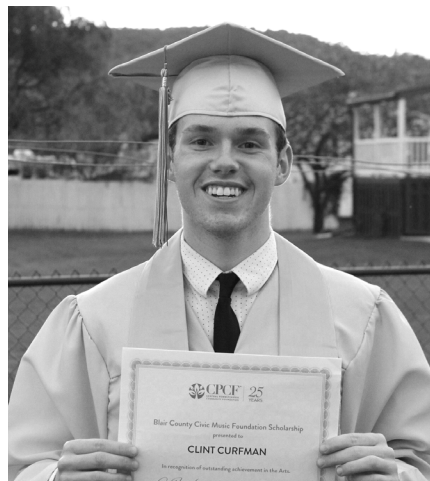
